

Summary of Information detailed on Examination Statements of Entry

The individual Statement of Entry details all GCSE entries made by the school for your child. This includes Written Examinations, Controlled Assessment and Practical Examinations. It is also a requirement that the school enters students for the GCSE Certificate for individual subjects. The Certificate entry in effect “cashes in” the GCSE and provides an overall grade.

Written Examinations listed on the Statement of Entry will state the entry code, the subject entered, **Board Timetabled** and this will be followed by the date and time of the Examination.

Controlled Assessment/ Practical Examinations will state the entry code and the subject entered. This will be followed by **Not Timetabled** because there is no written examination for these units and the Controlled Assessment/ Practical Assessment will be taken or will have been taken during school time.

Certificate entries will state the entry code and the subject only.
