



Life at SPH

Thank you for your interest in the position currently being advertised at St Philip Howard Catholic High School (SPH). I would like to take this opportunity to give you a taste of 'Life at SPH' to help you decide if this is the right opportunity for you.

SPH is a co-educational 11-18 Catholic comprehensive school, which from April 2017 will become an academy within the Bosco Catholic Education Trust. The school and academy trust's ethos is based on its Catholic character and good relations are central to our work. As a consequence, both students and staff are happy, positive and enjoy their time at school.

Standards at SPH are outstanding with the vast majority of students achieving very well. In last year's GCSE examinations 86% of students gained five or more A* - C grades (80% including English and Maths) and the pass rate at A Level was 99% (54% A*/B). Despite the fact that these represent the best results in the school's history, exceed FFTD/ALPS targets, and place us in the Top 10% nationally for progress (RAISE VA of 1038 and ALPS grade 3), we have higher aspirations, believing that "getting better never stops!" We are determined to be outstanding in all aspects of our work as a school and pursue this goal relentlessly.

I was appointed as Headteacher in September 2012 and was immediately impressed by the commitment, attitude and hard work of students, staff, parents and governors. There is a great team here at SPH and we are all determined to be the very best we possibly can be. We hope that you will be up for this challenge too.

A great deal of emphasis is placed upon extra-curricular life at SPH and outside the formal curriculum there are numerous opportunities for students to take part in a wide range of activities - drama, sport, music, exchanges, days of reflection, Duke of Edinburgh and trips, both nationally and internationally. We would expect you to contribute in some way to this important side of school life should you be successful in your application.

SPH is heavily over-subscribed and is very highly regarded in the local community. Whilst students and staff are well supported, expectations of them are high. We are determined to recruit the very best teachers and those with great potential, to support and develop them in their roles and prepare them for promotion. That is why we invest heavily in professional development opportunities. Our staff are our number one asset and must be cherished if we are to succeed in achieving our goals.

We have a relentless focus on learning and the quality of teaching; under-performance will always be addressed and student outcomes placed at the heart of all we do. We were delighted to be graded as 'Outstanding' in every category at our most recent Ofsted inspection in April 2016 and believe this to be great affirmation of what we are trying to achieve. I hope you will take the opportunity to access the report on our school website.

The challenge now is to continue to improve and become the best school in the country. Are you the person to help us achieve this goal? We are in the process of applying for Teaching School status and already undertake outreach work to provide school improvement locally.
